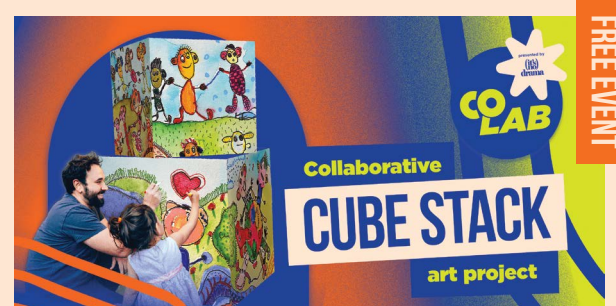


An Inclusive songwriting workshop
